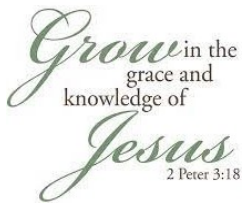

**Participate in Operation Rice Bowl** by taking a Rice Bowl from the breezeway of church. Rice Bowls are generally collected on Holy Thursday, the Rice Bowl collection is the Catholic Relief Services' Lenten faith-in-action program for parishes, schools and families. The program invites Catholics to live in solidarity with our poorest and most vulnerable brothers and sisters through the three Lenten pillars of praying, fasting, and almsgiving.

**Lenten Days of Fasting & Abstinence:** Fasting Days: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. Fasting means, eating only one meal that day. Two other smaller meals may be eaten which together would not equal a whole meal. The law of fasting binds all those from 18 to 59 years old. Days of Abstinence: Ash Wednesday, All Fridays of Lent & Good Friday. Abstinence means not eating meat (beef, pork, chicken, etc.) For this purpose, fish, eggs, cheese are not considered meat. The law of abstinence binds all who are over 14 years old.

**IN THE DESERT:** Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God’s presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God’s ways behind.
