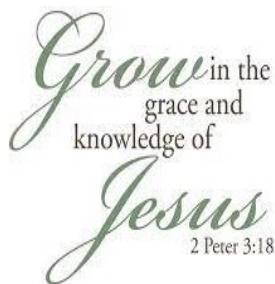
### ~Stewardship Reflections~
