-Stewardship Reflections-

"He said to his father in reply: 'Look, all these years I served you.....yet you never gave me even a young goat to feast on with my friends. But when your son returns who swallowed up your property with prostitutes, for him you slaughter the fattened calf.'" Luke 15:29-30

The father practiced God's version of generosity – unearned and unconditional. A steward sees a need and responds without asking questions concerning whether it is deserved or not.

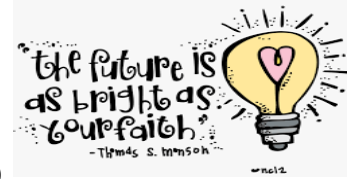
LOST AND FOUND: The parable of the father and his sons is one of the most familiar of all of Jesus' stories. The father in the parable is lavish in forgiveness and revels in the return of his young son, who was lost and now is found. The older son is also lost—lost in his refusal to forgive, lost in his failure to grasp his father's generous spirit. The Israelites spent many years lost in the desert, seeking the land of milk and honey, yet often failing to seek the God who delivered and fed them. We are sometimes lost as well.
