## RETREAT OPPORTUNITY

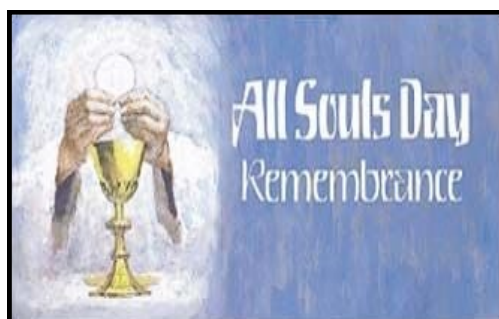
