A Time to Prepare

We will celebrate the **Sacrament of Reconciliation** in a **communal penance service** here at **St. Dominic** on **Tuesday, Dec. 13th, at 6:15 p.m.** in preparation for Christmas. Several priests will be available for the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Catholic High School Placement Test: Any 8th grader planning to or considering enrolling at Bethlehem High School next year as a freshman is asked to take the High School Placement Test on Saturday, December 10th, at Bethlehem.
